

## Jesus Has Overcome...Will you (Keep the Faith)?

Mark 5:21-43 (NIV)

A. We have at least \_\_\_ things, that if we allow them to, can hinder us from being overcomers.

1. Our \_\_\_\_\_ experiences and the mindset shaped by them (The woman with the bleeding issue)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of our suffering (v. 25)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of our suffering (v. 26a)
  - The perceived loss of \_\_\_\_\_ from our suffering (v. 26b)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of our suffering (v. 26c)

The woman could have concluded that in light of the past:

“Why would an encounter with Jesus yield a \_\_\_\_\_ result?”

2. Our \_\_\_\_\_ experiences and the mindset shaped by them (Jairus)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ associated with the potential resolution (vs. 23, 35)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of others not involved, who threaten the resolution (vs. 24, 27-33)
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of those who are involved in the resolution (vs. 35, 38-40a)

Jairus could have concluded that his faith was misplaced or that other people messed things up and that either way, it was \_\_\_\_\_.

B. The \_\_\_ keys to being an overcomer are found in Jesus’ words to them.

1. \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 34)

- Faith is Evidence, Assurance, Confirmation (Hebrews 11:1).
- It is what God’s people live according to (Galatians 2:20).

2. \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 36)

- Faith in action/corresponding works of obedience (James 2:14-26)

C. Those who refuse to believe the word of faith may not have the opportunity to see and experience the Kingdom’s power at work \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 37, 40b-43).
