3.	End result: Jesus' listeners were unable to receive (all) the blessings he wanted to bestow upon them, and he did not remain in their presence corporately as he did with others (v. 5-6).
4.	Those who later heard his disciples them as God's messengers. How do we know this?
	• Jesus sent them out without basic necessities, implying that these things will be provided to them by those who would receive them (vs. 7-10).
<u> </u>	The miracles were only done by those who and them (v. 11).
6.	End result: people receive their words and are blessed (v.12-13).
