## Day 1: Revelation for Repentance

As was mentioned in the Palm Sunday message earlier this week, God knows more about a person than anyone, including the person themselves. One can only offer up to God the things God has first shown them need to be offered and this by the grace He extends to them. This takes humility and the willingness to be still and listen.

Begin by positioning yourself to hear and receive from God, by confessing and repenting of sinful thoughts, words, and actions that you are aware of.

Then pray that the Holy Spirit would reveal to you those things in you that need to change and that you need to be delivered from, particularly the things you are not aware of.

Scripture Reading: Psalm 139:1-24

<u>A Prayer Primer You Might Use</u>: Almighty God, you are the only source of light, revelation, and newness of life for every soul. I need to acknowledge and confess my sin, but I need your help. There are things I know about but have hardened my heart and neglected to confess and repent of:

(confess and repent of these now).

There are also things within me that are hidden that I am not aware of, things holding me back from greater selfawareness, freedom, and a deeper relationship with you and others. Lord, please reveal these to me that I may repent of them, yield myself to you, and allow you to exercise your Lordship over them.

(Spend time listening and confess and repent of anything revealed to you. Journaling may be beneficial.)

After time reflecting, confessing, and repenting, sing a song of praise that comes to mind. Thank God for what he has revealed to you, and for His forgiveness.
